CONSTITUTION OF PRISMPREAMBLE




MEMBERSHIP

Article 1 : There will be following Five catagories of members.

- 1. Founder Member
- 2. Very Special Member
- 3. Special Member
- 4. General Member
- 5. Honorary Member.

Article 2 : Any citizen of India who agree with the constitution, principles & policies of PRISM is eligible for membership.

Article 3 : A Founder member is one who has contributed his name as such to the memorandum of the association. He shall remain a very special member & a member of the National Working Committee throughout his life unless he resigns or is removed.

Article 4 : A person who will devote atleast average seven days per month honorary for party programme shall be very special member.

Article 5 : A person who will devote average atleast three days per month will be a special member.

Article 6 : A person who will help directly or indirectly for propogation of Party programmes will be a general member.

Article 7 : An Honorary member is one who is unanimously elected by the Tehsil, District or National Working Committee on the account of his distinguished public service.

Article 8 ; Very special membership will be given by any member of National Working Committee, special membership by any very special member & General Membership by any special member.

Article 9 : If any member acts against the interest of the party or violates the constitution, resolutions or, instructions or any rules of party, he shall be removed from the membership or the office which he helds provided a show-cause notice has been served up to him and necessary inquiry in his conduct has been made and a resolution to this effect has been passed by the National working Committee for very special member, by District Working committee for special member & by local Unit working Committee for General member, by a majority of two third of it's total members present & a majority of it's total members.

Article 10: No Member will be removed from membership for a period more than a period of two years unless he is found guilty of dishonesty in the fund of party.

Article 11: Membership fee will be as follows.

P A R T - IIIElections

- Article 1 : Every member of party and of the working Committee shall have one vote. The Election will be held within every two years.
- Article 2 : The smallest local unit of party will be at the Tehsil level & similiar levels fixed by District Working Committee.
- Article 3 : All the members of party, local unit will elect the members of local working committee, number of which may vary^a from five to ten, decided by District Working Committee.
- Article 4 : Local Unit Working Committeewill elect their President & Secretary, who may be or may not be a member of Local Unit working Committee.
- Article 5 : All male members of local unit will elect their Vice President (Male). Female members of Local Unit will elect the Vice President (Female) of related Unit. Both Vice Presidents may be or may not be the members of Local Working Committee.
- Article 6 : Only special member may be elected for local working Committee, President, Secretary & Vice-Presidents.
- Article 7 : All the members of Local Working Committees of any district will elect the members of District Working Committee^{number of} ~~no.~~ which may be between Five to Ten number of which will be decided by National Working Committee.
- Article 8 : District Working Committee will elect their President, & Secretary who may be or may not be a member of District Working Committee.
- Article 9 : Female Vice Presiednts of all Local Units of related district will elect the district Vice-President. (Female) & Male Vice Presidents of all local units of related district will elect

P A R T - VNATIONAL PRESIDENT

- Article 1 : The executive power of the PRISM shall be vested in the National President of PRISM & shall be exercised by him directly or with the help of General Secretary, Convener, Treasurer & Vice Presidents.
- Article 2 : The Presidents term of office is two years but he will held the post further till his successor enters upon office. The President may resign, by writing under his hand, addressed to General Secretary. General Secretary will communicate the resignation to the National Council.
- Article 3 : When President is to be impeached for violation of the constitution, National Working Committee may proceeds by framing the charges against President in the form of a resolution after seven days notice, signed by not less then one fourth of the total number of members.
- The resolution should be passed by not less then three-fourth of the total members present & two third of total number of members in National working Committee.
- Article 4 : President shall appoint National Convener, National treasurer, & other office bearers.
- Article 5 : President has the power to dismiss any person from any post within the party which is not a elected post.
- Article 6 : The President shall be the Head of party.
- Article 7 : The president shall preside over the meeting of the National assembly, National Working Committee and in his absence by a nominee of the President.

Article 8 : It shall be duty of the President to see that the objects, Constitution, rules and regulations of the party, the resolutions of the National Assembly are executed and followed properly by the office bearers. Article 20: He shall open bank account as instructed by the National ^{Working} Committee and will keep all funds in the bank except upto Rs. 5000/- which he may keep in his custody for day to day affairs.

Article 21: National Treasurer will be ex-office member of National Working Committee.

Article 22: National Treasure will appoint the treasurers of other smaller units for his help ^{who} will held the post till the pleasure of National Treasurer.


P A R T - VICHAPTER - IGENERAL ASSEMBLY

- Article 1 : All the members of PRISM of any local unit will be the members of related General assembly, Secretary of that unit will be the Chairman of related General Assembly.
- Article 2, : General Assembly will be at Tehsil level & at other levels decided by District Working Committee.
- Article 3 : Meetings of General Assembly will be held at least once in three months. Convener of related unit will convene the meetings of General Assembly.
- Article 4 : All the matters related to workings, meetings, duties, Powers & responsibilities of General Assembly will be decided by National Working Committee or by any person or body authorised by National Working Committee.

CHAPTER - IIDISTRICT ASSEMBLY

- Article 5 : All the members of Local Working Committee of related district will be the member of District Assemblies. District Secretary of related district will be the chairman of that district Assembly.
- Article 6 : Meetings of District Assembly will be held at least once in six months. District Convener will convene the meetings of District Assembly.



Article 7 : All the matters related to Working, meetings, duties, powers & responsibilities of District assembly will be decided by National Working Committee.

CHAPTER - III

NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

Article 8 : Meeting of National Assembly will be held at least once in a year.

Article 9 : Resolution for changes in policies & Principles will be passed by National Assembly by not less than two third members present & majority of total Number of members.

Article 10 : Budget proposals will be passed by General Majority.

Article 11 : Resolution for dissolution of Party will be passed by National Assembly by not less than 90% majority of its total members.

Article 12 : If the Resolution of dissolution of party is not passed then the membership of National assembly & membership of PRISM of all members voting in favour of dissolution will cancel itself.

Article 13 : National assembly has the Supreme Authority in the party.

Article 14 : All the members who held the posts above the district level (whether elected, nominated or appointed) will be the members of National assembly.

Article 15 : General Secretary will be Chairman of National Assembly.

Article 16 : National Convener will convene the meetings of National Assembly.


- Article 17 : Old National assembly will work untill new National assembly is duly elected.
- Article 18 : National Assembly can be summoned to meet at one month's prior notice given on the address of the members given by them by ordinary post or otherwise.
- Article 19 : The quorum of meeting of the National Assembly shall be one third of its total members.
- Article 20 : If at a meeting of the National Assembly the quorum is not forth-coming on the scheduled time, it shall be adjourned by the president for one day.
- Article 21 : The Scheduled business of the general meeting shall be transected in the adjourned meeting held after a day, for such adjourned meeting neither notice nor quorum shall be necessary.
- Article 22 : Annual general meeting shall be called with in three months after the end of the year. The annual report of the institution a-long with its audited account shall be sent to all members with the notice of the meeting.

- Article 25 : The National Assembly will transect its business by resolutions put up by any member and passed by the majority votes of the members present, the resolutions must be sent to the General Secretary at least three days before the meeting but the President shall have a right to condone this delay.

Article 26 : The National Assembly shall have a right to frame rules and prescribe the procedure, the method for keeping the accounts, office management and all the activities of the party.

Article 27 : The National Assembly shall have a right to instruct, advise or order by resolution to the National Working Committee.

- Article 1 : Members of Local Working Committee will be elected amongst the General assembly & by the member of General assembly through the decided procedure of constitution.
- Article 2 : President of related Unit will be the head of that Working Committee.
- Article 3 : All the matters related to workings, meetings, duties powers & responsibilities of local working committee & its members will be decided by National Working Committee & District Working Committee.
- Article 4 : President of that unit will carry on his business related to Party with the help of Convener, Treasurer, Secretary & Members of Working Committee through the procedure decided by National Working & district Working Committee.

CHAPTER - IIDISTRICT WORKING COMMITTEE

NATIONAL WORKING COMMITTEE

Article 1 : National Working Committee shall consist of Founder Members & members elected by National Assembly. The number of elected members of National Working Committee will be 20.

Article 2 : The National Assembly by resolution may increase or decrease the number of members of National Working Committee, but in no case it shall be more than Twenty five.

Article 3 : Twenty Five percent members will be elected by Female Group, twenty five percent by male group & Fifty percent by Joint group.

Article 4 : The terms of office of National Working Committee will be of two years.

Article 5 : Till the new members of the National Working Committee are not duly elected, the old will continue to work as such.

Article 6 : The National Working Committee ~~will~~ shall ordinarily be summoned to meet atleast one week prior notice.

Article 7 : The National Working Committee shall meet atleast once in six months or at any time when President considers it necessary.

- Article 8 : The National Working Committee shall be Custodian, Controller & manager of the movable & immovable property of the party through it's office bearers.

Article 18 : There will be a board of advisors to advise the National Working Committee.

Article 20 : Twenty Five Senior most very special members of Party will be the members of Board of Advisors.

Article 21 : National Advisor will convey the opinion of Board of Advisors to National Working Committee regarding any issue, after sufficient discussion in the Board of Advisors.

P A R T - V I I IFUNDS :

- Article (i) The funds of the party shall consist of the subscriptions of the members, donations by the members or non-members, and miscellaneous amounts received by the party.
- Article (ii) All funds shall be kept in bank specified by the National Working Committee.
- Article (iii) The bank accounts shall be operated in the name of the party and will be operated jointly under the signatures of any two out of the President General Secretary and Treasurer.
- Article (iv) For the proper utilization and procurement of the funds a budget shall be prepared by the Treasurer before the year ends and he will get it approved by the National Working Committee.
- Article (v) If for any reason the budget for the coming year is not passed in time the income and expenditure may be made according to the last year's budget.
- Article (vi) Till the first membership campaign is completed and the Working Committee is formed according to the Constitution and the first budget is passed the founder members will exercise all the powers of the National Working Committee and office bearers regarding the working and the expenditure of the party.




